**AWARDS:** Trophies 1st thru 3rd, medals 4th thru 8th. Outstanding Wrestler Trophy in each division based on champion with most falls in least amount of time (including technical falls). Each division will have a Team Champion and a runner-up based on point criteria 14-10-7-4-2-1; if tied, second criteria will be highest placement.
