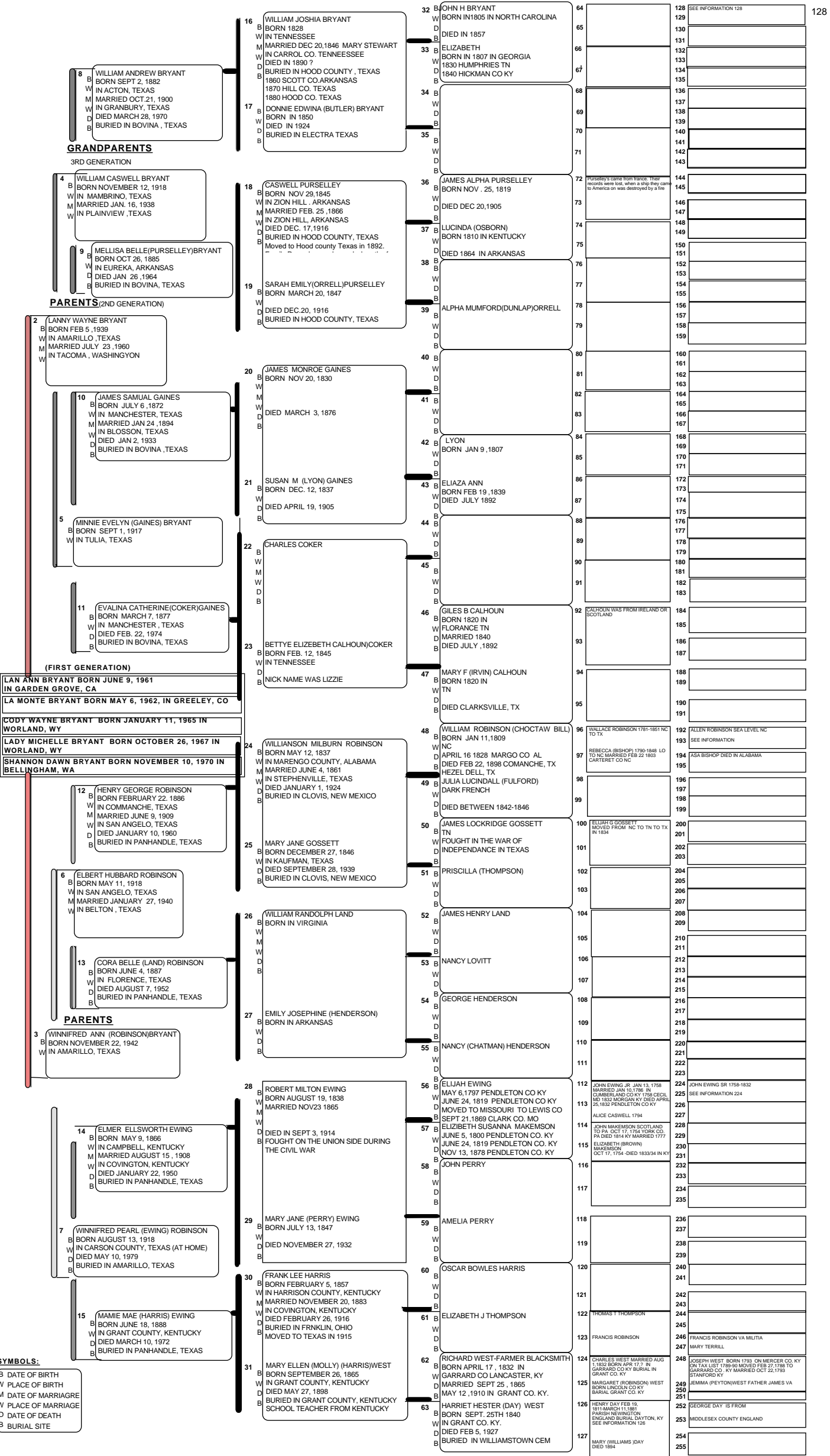

JOHN EWING BORN JUNE 7, 1732 CUMBERLAND CO NJ MARRIED MAY 3, 1755 CUMBERLAND CO NJ AND DIED AFTER 1784 JOHN EWING IS THE SON OF THOMAS EWING

JOHN EWING SENIOR BORN IN CECIL CO MD IN 1758 DIED APRIL 19 1832 NEAR MORGAN KY SERVED IN THE AMERICAN REVOLUTIONARY WAR. HE WAS ONE OF THE INCORPORATORS OF THE CITY OF FALMOUTH KY AND WAS ONE OF THE FIRST JUSTICE OF THE PEACE. MARRIED SEPT 3 1825 TO MARY MCCANN WIDOW OF LANTY MCCANN. MARY DIED OCT. 5, 1838 JOHN EWING SENIOR IS THE SON OF JOHN EWING
