### **Iowa Central Three-Peats as NJCAA National Champions**

Meramec's Winn is Outstanding Wrestler By John Johnson

ochester, MN.— Luke Moffitt and the Triton's of Ft. Dodge, Iowa, have pulled the proverbial hattrick by three-peating in the NJCAA National Wrestling Championships held at Rochester Community and Technical College in Minnesota.

At the start of the day on Saturday, Iowa Central held a slim four point lead over Labette College (KS), with both teams having seven wrestlers still alive as did second rated Meramec. Iowa Central would get a little more breathing room as they sent three wrestlers into the finals. Meramec and North Iowa also matched IC's three finalists, Labette had one finalist, and there still was a battle for second, third, and fourth place.

In the first bout of the night at 125-pounds the top two seeded wresters would match up for the second time this season. Northwest Wyoming's Jeremy Ensley (Homedale, ID) 31-5 overall and undefeated in the IUCO

ranks would face Iowa Central's Terrance Young (Minneapolis, MN) who was 33-3 over all and 18-1 in NJCAA action. Young's only loss came at the hand of Ensley at the Apadaca Duals in Wyoming, 3-2. Terrance Young the first of three Triton finalists would start Ĭowa Central out on the right foot with a 3-1 decision over Jeremy Ensley of Northwest Wyoming, avenging his only JUCO loss on

The Triton's next foe would be Aaron Sanzee from Meramec at 141, and the Magic were trying to move up from third to second place in the team standings. Labette had the runner-up slot headed into the finals with a lone finalist, and Meramec had three finalists as did NIACC, who was also looking to improve in their national finish. For Senzee (Kearney, MO), it would not come easy in the title match. His opponent, David Greenwald of Iowa Central, established a 5-0 lead in the first period, nearly pinning Senzee. In January at the National Duals, Greenwald pinned Senzee in just 22 seconds. However, the Meramec grappler battled back, scoring seven unanswered points and held on for a 7-6 championship victory.

Iowa Central's last finalist, second-ranked freshman Brad Lower (Burlington, IA) was undefeated in junior college action entering the finals with an 18-0 record. Lower's opponent in the 165-pound final was fourth-ranked Mike Morgan (Berryhill, OK) of Labette, who was 10-2 in NJCAA matches with one loss coming from Lower at the Cliff Keen national duals, 4-0. The Card's Mikey Morgan would even his win-loss record with Lower at 1-1, as he edged IC's Brad Lower 7-6 for the title and a little payback. With Lower's loss, the Tritons would go 1 for 3 in the finals, but still had the team to take the D-







their best team finishes in school history.

The Magic's champions earn All-American status along with teammates Bobby Conn at 157 (Marquette), Miles Bolin at 125 (Ft. Zumwalt W.), Donald Woods (McCluer N.) at 165, and Dirk Hurrin (St. Agnes, VA) at 174. Hurrin won a fifth place medal, while Conn and Bolin placed sixth, and Woods came in seventh. The second place team finish, three individual champions, and seven All-Americans are all school records for one season

Another team looking to move up in the final team score was NIACC who matched Meramec's three champions as Albert White (Harvey, II) improved his undefeated record in JC's to 20-0 at 149 as he downed TJ Hepburn Ledyard, CT) of Colby, 3-2. This was White's third win over Hepburn for the year, but with both wrestlers being freshman and baring any transferring, these two top wrestlers could meet again! Another set of freshman would meet in the finals at 157pounds; Marshall Giovanni of Highline would bring a perfect 25-0 JC record to the finals where he would meet NIACC's Davaughn Perkins (Omaha, NE) who was 16-1 in JUCO matches. Perkins would edge Marshall Giovanni of Highline, 9-8, for the second individual title for NIACC. Third ranked Jason Green (Pawnee, OK) of Neosho would face NIACC's Glenn Rhees for the 174pound title. Both sophomores, Rhees would decision Green, 7-3 for the 174# title, and gave head coach Rich Fregola and the newly reinstated North Iowa team 109 points, a fourth place finish, and three national champions.

In the non-scholarship division, Nassau C.C. had an insurmountable lead heading into the finals and would go two-for-two in adding to their point total finishing up with 88.5 points. In a bout of two undefeated JC wrestlers at 133-pounds, Chris Notte of Nassau (Riverton, NJ, 18-0) downed Nick Mamalis (Green River, WY, 12-0) Western Wyoming, 6-2. With a 20-1 JUCC record and ranked second, John Bates (Oregon City, OR) a two-time region champion and 3rd place finisher in the 2007 JC tournament would face a 5-3 JC freshman in Nassau's Brandon Williamson (Riverside, CT) at 285. Records aside, Williamson beat John Bates, 7-4. With two national champions and the non-scholarship team title in hand; Coach Paul Schmidt of Nassau was named the "coach of the year" for the non-scholarship schools for his teams' effort. Harper College (Ill) finished in second, and host Rochester finished in third place for the non-scholarship teams.

Tritons beat Meramec by 20.5 points for the scholarship title. Iowa Central finished with 138 points, while Meramec (117.5) was second. Labette (111) placed third. The Tritons came away with one champion and two runners-up on the final day, as seven of their 10 qualifying individuals reached the podium and All-American status. "When we won it the first time, you kind of start to expect it the second time," said ICCC coach Luke Moffitt. "To win it three times in a row, though, we're now establishing ourselves as the nation's most dominant junior college program. When people think junior college wrestling, we want them to think Iowa Central. We set the bar high, and the kids come down and perform at a higher standard to reach their goals."

Harry McGinnis of Triton was named the NJCAA "Man-of-the-Year," the Ernest B. Gould Outstanding Wrestler Award went to Deron Winn of Meramec, Randy Moore of Gloucester received the Joseph E. Rockenback Sportsmanship Award, Donte Butler of Neosho had four falls in 5:49 to earn

the Bruce Traphagen Fall Award, Labette College was named the NJCAA Academic Wrestling Team. Five people were inducted into the NJCAA Wrestling Hall of Fame on Saturday, prior to the finals. Those inducted were Dan Loprieno- Harper, Tony Kenning-Ridgewater, Colothdian Tate-Colby, Daniel Breedlove-Blackhawk, and John Johnson-Iowa.

Iowa Central is only the third team ever to win three straight crowns. North Idaho and Lassen (Calif.) have previously won four straight. North Idaho did it from 1985-88. Lassen did it from 1995-98. The Triton's will be gunning for their fourth straight title in 2009!! So, make plans now to join us in Rochester in late February, where once again Chuck Siefert from Rochester Community and Technical College and Ed Hruska from the Rochester Amateur Sports Commission along with their dedicated staff will again host the NJCAA nationals, which is arguably one of the best run tournaments in the nation in a super location.




