

Wrestling: Seven Hofstra Wrestlers Place In The Top Four At The Journeymen Collegiate Classic

Troy, NY – Senior Michael Hughes won the 285 pool and six more Hofstra Wrestlers placed in the top four in their pools at the 2017 Journeymen Collegiate Classic at Hudson Valley Community College Sunday afternoon.

Hughes, who improved to 6-0 on the year with three victories, defeated Oklahoma State junior Derek White in the 285-lb. championship match, 1-0.

Three Pride grapplers placed third as sophomore Jacob Martin posted a 2-1 mark on the day in the 125B pool, red-shirt freshman Garrett Lambert was 1-2 to finish third in the 133B pool and red-shirt junior Connor Muli was 1-2 in the 149C pool.

Three Hofstra wrestlers finished in fourth place as junior Nezar Haddad was 2-2 in the 197B pool, red-shirt freshman Charlie Kane was 1-2 in the 141C pool and sophomore Sage Heller was 1-2 in the 165B pool.

Two Pride members placed fifth as red-shirt freshman Ricky Stamm was 0-2 on the mat with a win by forfeit in the fifth-place match and junior Michael Oxley was 1-2 in the 197B pool.

Red-shirt juniors Bobby Fehr and Cory Damiana each placed sixth with 0-3 marks in the 174A and 184A pools, respectively.

Hofstra will return to action on Saturday, November 18 when they compete in the Navy Classic in Annapolis, Maryland. Tournament time is 10 a.m.
