## **Wrestling: Hofstra Announces 2019-20 Wrestling Schedule**

Hempstead, NY – Hofstra University Head Wrestling Coach Dennis Papadatos today announced his 2019-20 schedule which includes a 12-match home slate for the Pride.

In addition to the 12 home matches, the 2019-20 Hofstra Wrestling schedule also includes four in-season tournaments and two post-season tournaments in the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) Championship at Lehigh University on March 6-7, and the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships in Minneapolis, Minnesota from March 19-21.

“This year’s schedule came out about as perfect as we could hope for,” Papadatos stated. “We have put together a slate of 12 home matches out of a total of 16 dual contests. We have some premium events on the schedule that we believe will get the team ready for championship competition in March.”

The 2019-20 Pride schedule kicks off in November with three tournaments as Hofstra competes in the Princeton Open on November 3, the Journeymen/MyHouse Northeast Classic on November 10, and the Black Knight Invitational at Army West Point on November 17.

Hofstra begins its dual match home schedule on Thursday, November 21 against the Falcons of Air Force at the David S. Mack Sports and Exhibition Complex. It will be the first of nine matches in the Mack Sports Complex with the other three (Davidson, Franklin and Marshall and Columbia) in the adjacent David S. Mack Physical Education Building.

The Pride will compete in the prestigious Cliff Keen-Las Vegas Invitational on Friday and Saturday, December 6-7 before returning to dual match competition for the remainder of the regular season. The West Virginia Quad in Morgantown, West Virginia kicks off the restart of duals on December 22 when the Pride will face Edinboro, VMI and the host Mountaineers.

January and the New Year brings six home matches as Bloomsburg (Jan. 5), The Citadel (Jan. 11), Binghamton (Jan. 12), North Carolina State (Jan. 18), LIU (Jan. 26), and Davidson (Jan. 31). February brings the Pride six matches on four dates as Hofstra hosts Columbia and Franklin and Marshall in a tri-event on February 1, a road match at George Mason on February 9, home matches against Brown and Harvard on February 16, and the Senior Day regular season finale against Sacred Heart on February 22.
