COLUMBUS, **Ohio** – The Ohio State University wrestling program added 13 newcomers to the 2017-18 roster, welcoming in a group of 10 freshmen and three transfers. Six different states are representing in the recruiting class, including a half dozen native Buckeyes from the great state of Ohio.

Te'Shan Campbell I Jr. I 165 lbs. I Pittsburgh, Pa.

- Two-time NCAA qualifier (2016, 2017) for the University of Pittsburgh
