Three OCU wrestlers snare titles in SAC Championships

OKLAHOMA CITY – Three Oklahoma City University wrestlers took individual titles to lead the Stars to a second-place finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference women's wrestling championships Sunday at Abe Lemons Arena.

Sydney Freund at 143 pounds, Cierra Foster (155) and Nkechinyere Nwankwo (191) became conference individual champions for the Stars, ranked 10th in the NAIA. OCU's Raven Guidry (116) and Mattison Parker (136) grabbed runner-up finishes.

Sophia Smith at 130 and Victoria Hinojo at 191 picked up third place, while Brooklyn Hermal (116) and Irene Sanchez (143) came in fourth for Oklahoma City. Third- and fourth-place finishers reeled in honorable-mention all-SAC.

The Stars' Marissa Gregoire at 101 and Michaela Childs at 109 were fifth-place finishers. Third-ranked Wayland Baptist (Texas) won the SAC title with 144.5 points, while OCU totaled 116.5 points.

Nwankwo hauled in her second 191-pound conference championship. Nwankwo, a junior from Houston went 3-0 with two technical falls Sunday. Nwankwo is rated

junior from Houston, went 3-0 with two technical falls Sunday. Nwankwo is rated No. 2 among NAIA 191-pounders.

Freund forged a 3-0 mark with a technical fall and a fall in the tournament. Freund, a senior from San Tan Valley, Ariz., pinned Texas Wesleyan's Maryellen Lafferty in 4:28. Freund, ranked second nationally, is 5-1 in 2020-21.

Foster, a senior from Post Falls, Idaho, won the 155-pound SAC title by default. Foster, ranked No. 1 in the NAIA, has a 3-0 record this season.

Guidry, a senior from Lafayette, La., posted a 5-1 record with two pins on the day, and Parker, a sophomore from Haslet, Texas, went 1-1 in the tournament. Guidry tied for the most falls in the tournament. Guidry's 44-second fall against Emma De Brum of Lyon (Ark.) accounted for OCU's quickest pin of the tournament.

The Stars wrestle next in the NAIA Invitational on March 12-13 in Jamestown, N.D.
