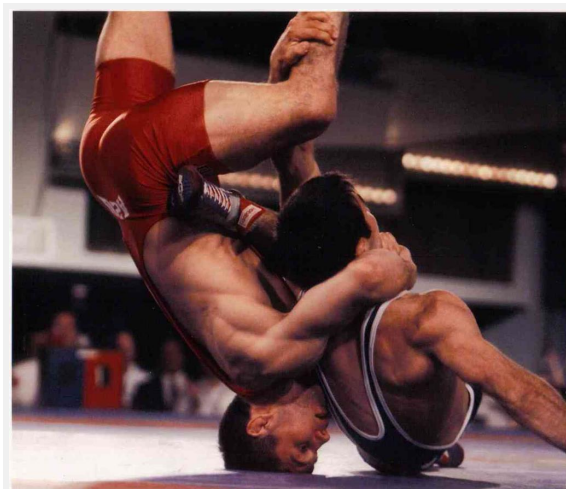

I'm sure 'national meets' are important for many parents, but I feel training is far more important.
