Leading the team was Dylan Hendrickson of West Jordan. He won silver in folkstyle and bronze in both freestyle and Greco-Roman, all at 15 to 18 120 lbs. All of his wins in each tournaments came by way of fall.

Mountain Top wrestlers made three more appearances in the finals: in freestyle, Gabriel Foote of West Valley City, 6 and Under 45 lbs.; in both freestyle and Greco-Roman, Min Htet of Salt Lake City, 15 to 18 113 lbs.

Earning four more bronze medals were two athletes: Koda Foote, 10 and Under 53 lbs.; and Max Greenwood at 15 to 18 220 lbs. and 285 lbs. in freestyle, and 15 to 18 22 lbs. in folkstyle

Athletes earned five fourth-place medals: Kale Zorn of West Jordan at 12 & Under 68 lbs. in both freestyle and Greco-Roman; Colten Dallof of West Jordan at 12 and Under 74 lbs.; and Greenwood at 15 to 18 285 lbs.

"The competition was tough this weekend," said Coach Nate Rogers, "but the guys rose to the occasion. We had multiple matches against national champs and really made a good showing. We're very proud of the progress they're making."
