

YORK, PA. – Freshman Demitreus Henry (Brooklyn/Grand Street Campus) earned four decisions to capture the individual title in the 174-pound weight class at the two-day York New Standard Invitational. Sophomore Gianni Silba (Newark Valley) also placed, finishing 6-2 to secure fifth place at 157 pounds.

Henry opened with a 6-2 win over Ryan Haas of Baldwin Wallace. He advanced to the semifinals with an 8-4 decision against Ithaca's Steve Rice, and earned a trip to the title bout on a 6-3 victory versus Brett Leonard of Roger Williams. Henry secured the title with a 9-5 decision over Dan Kilroy of The College of New Jersey.

Silba began his run to his fifth-place finish with a 10-4 decision over York's Jake Stasil. After falling to Tyler Gazaway of Roger Williams, Silba strung together four straight wins to advance to the consolation semifinals. It began with a 21-6 technical fall versus Brockport's Jordan Kayes. Next came a 5-4 decision against Giancarlo Crivelli of The College of New Jersey, followed by an 11-2 major decision versus Ryan Orr of Baldwin Wallace. A 12-5 win versus Mark Gerstacker of TCNJ pitted Silba against Gazaway again, but Silba fell, 10-2. He earned a medical forfeit win in the fifth-place match.

Senior Alex D'Angelo (Thiells/North Rockland) and sophomore Matt Maquet (Long Beach) each posted 3-2 records over the weekend. At 141 pounds, D'Angelo earned 13-2 and 13-4 major decisions over Connor Mauriello of Johns Hopkins and Connor Murphy of TCNJ, respectively), and a 6-1 decision versus Steven Schwab of TCNJ. Maquet, competing at 133 pounds, recorded bonus points in two of his wins. He registered a 10-0 major decision over Jace Garza of Merchant Marine to begin the weekend. After a loss in the round of 16, Maquet defeated Jon Mejia of Roger Williams, 10-6, and earned a fall in 42 seconds over Brockport's John Cantwell. His tournament ended with a tough 7-5 sudden-victory to Matt Armamento of Johnson & Wales.

Two other Red Dragons posted multiple wins. At 165 pounds, sophomore Charlie Spada (Long Beach) went 2-2, winning his first two bouts, including a pin of Zachary Goranson of Ursinus in 3:31. At 197 pounds, sophomore Ryan O'Shea (Levittown/MacArthur) also posted victories in his first two contests that featured a pin of A.J. White of Apprentice in 1:49

Cortland finished ninth in the final team standings with 55 points. Johnson and Wales was the team champion with 154.5 points.

The Red Dragons will host the Cortland Open, on Saturday, Dec. 9.
