• Twenty-three Auggie wrestlers, primarily varsity reserves, competed at the tournament, going 66-36 on the day with 15 pins, nine technical falls and nine major decisions. Thirteen Auggies claimed top-six finishes.

- Ethan Winkelman (FY, Hudson, Wis /Hudson HS) dominated the 197-pound weight class, opening with a major decision, then recording three third-period technical falls to claim the title, improving to 22-2 on the season with 10 pins, four technical falls and six major decisions. • Karson Casper (JR, Coleman, Wis./Coleman HS) and Lucas Jagodzinske (JR, Sherburn, Minn./Martin County West HS) shared the title at
- 149 pounds, with Casper going 3-0 with a pin, and Jagodzinske going 3-0 with a pin and major decision. Charlie Stuhl (SR, Ellsworth, Wis./Ellsworth HS) and Blake Jagodinske (SR, Sherburn, Minn./Martin County West HS) shared the title at
